

LOUIS J. MILIONE, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. I am a citizen and a resident of the United States. Since 1997, I have been a Special Agent of the Drug Enforcement Administration ("DEA"). Since 2007, I have served as the Group Supervisor of the DEA's Narco-Terrorism Group. In that capacity, I have participated in and supervised the DEA's investigation of VIKTOR BOUT (hereafter "BOUT") in the case of United States v. VIKTOR BOUT, a/k/a "Boris," a/k/a "Victor Anatoliyevich Bout," a/k/a "Victor But," a/k/a "Viktor Budd," a/k/a "Viktor Butt," a/k/a "Viktor Bulakin," a/k/a "Vadim Markovich Aminov", Criminal Docket Number 08 Cr. 365 (the "Indictment"), and am familiar with the facts of the investigation.
